Grade 1 Community Learning Plan

Literacy Activities

- **Practice** the *Week 9 Spelling* words.
 - Take time every day this week to practice spelling.
 - Do your spelling test on **Friday**.
 - Remember your parents *are not allowed* to help.
- **Watch** the *Writing Week 8* video and spend 10 minutes writing.
 - 3 times this week spend 10 minutes writing.
- **Watch** the *Reading Week 9* video and complete the 'oa' and 'oe' Vowel Team Assignment.
- 3 times this week, set up your **reading workshop centers** and spend 10 minutes at each: paper work, silent reading, technology (Raz Kids, Teach Me Grade 1 or any other educational app you have access to) and a game (any games you have access to that incorporate reading).
- Do some **Home-Shared Reading (Raz Kids)**.
 - Try to read at least 1 book each day and do the quiz that goes with it.
- **Watch** the *Read Aloud Week 9* video and answer the following questions:
 - God created a beautiful world! What are 2 things that people often do to ruin God's creation?
 - Why is a clean world so important for God's animals?
 - What are 2 things you can do to show that you are being an Earth Keeper?
 - List 6 verbs (action words) from the book.

Numeracy Activities

- **Watch** the *Numeracy Lesson 14* video and spend 10 minutes at each math workshop center:
 - Video activity worksheet
 - Math notebook (cut and paste)
 - Math booklet (pencil work)
 - Technology (Teach Me Grade 1, Prodigy Math or any other educational app you have access to)
 - Game (any games you have access to that incorporate math - dice games, card games, etc.).
- **Practice** your Mad Minute at least 3 times this week.
 - Keep track of how long it takes you each time and see if you can pass the level by doing it in under a minute.
- **Watch** the *Numeracy Lesson 15* video and spend 10 minutes at each math workshop center (see above).
